CCMAR/BPD/07/2021

International call for a Post-Doctoral Fellowship in the scientific field of Biological Sciences, within the scope of the project SMARTCELL funded by the European Regional Development Fund (FEDER) through the Operational Programme for Algarve (PO CRESC ALGARVE 2020).

I - Introduction

On the 09th day of September, two thousand and twenty-one, at 11am, the Jury nominated for the call with reference CCMAR/BPD/07/2021, gathered through the Zoom platform, for the allocation of a Post-Doctoral Fellowship in the field of Biological Sciences within the research project: ALG-01-0247-FEDER-047169, named as "SMARTCELL" funded by the European Regional Development Fund (FEDER) through the Operational Programme for Algarve (PO CRESC ALGARVE 2020) The jury, composed by Professor Eduardo José Xavier Rodrigues de Pinho e Melo, Associate Professor with agregação at Algarve University and researcher at CCMAR (President); Doctor Liliana Isabel Tomé dos Anjos, researcher at UALG and CCMAR (Member) and Doctor Rute Castelo Félix, researcher at UALG and CCMAR (Member) had the following points of agenda: admission and evaluation of applications admitted to the fellowship CCMAR/BPD/07/2021.

II - Candidates

Four applications were received for the position of post-doctoral researcher:

Yuanheng Zhao

António Araújo Rego

Balamurugan Ramachandran

Mario Ledesma Terron

III - Exclusion of applications

The jury analysed the applications, considering the mandatory documents, and decided to exclude three candidates (Table 1), for the following reasons:

Candidates Yuanheng Zhao and Balamurugan Ramachandran did not provide the copy of the acknowledgement of the request for recognition of the PhD degree by a Portuguese Public Higher Education Institution, mandatory for applicants that could not upload a copy of the PhD diploma from a Portuguese Higher Education Institution or a copy of the certificate of recognition of the Doctoral degree by a Portuguese Public Higher Education Institution or by DGES.

Candidate António Araújo Rego has obtained his PhD degree in 2017, so longer than three years prior to the submission of these applications.

Thus, Mario Ledesma Terron candidate was admitted to the evaluation and ranking phase (Table 2).

IV - Evaluation of applications

The Jury evaluated the curriculum vitae of the eligible candidate (Table 2) and applied the classification criteria and weighting factors set out in the vacancy announcement as shown in table 3 below:

Evaluation criteria and respective weighting:

Criterion 1 - Merit of scientific curriculum, based on the number and quality of scientific publications (70%);

Criterion 2 - Experience in animal cell culture (20%);

Criterion3 - Other aspects scientifically relevant in the scientific curriculum such as communications in scientific meetings and fluency in English language (10%).

Note: The final grades in table 3 represent the average of the individual evaluation performed by each member of the jury, presented on a scale from 0 to 100%.

Table 4 presents the overall classification in order of rank.
