### CCMAR/BINCGAM/10/2021

International call for one (01) Research Fellowship (BI) for a person with a Master Degree (Bolsa de Investigação não conducente à obtenção de grau académico para mestre), within the scope of the research project: “Aplicação de Tecnologias Inovadoras e Sustentáveis de Processamento e de Monitorização de Qualidade de Produtos Alimentares do Mar” reference MAR-01.03.01-FEAMP-0050 cofunded by the Operational Programme Mar 2020, Portugal 2020 and the European Union through the European Fund for Maritime Affairs and Fisheries.

#### I - Introduction

On the 5 day of November, two thousand and twenty-one, at 10:00 h am , the nominated Jury for the call with reference CCMAR/BINCGAM/10/2021, gathered through the Zoom platform, for the allocation of one (01) fellowship for a person with a Master Degree (Bolsa de Investigação não conducente à obtenção de grau académico para mestre) within the research project: “Aplicação de Tecnologias Inovadoras e Sustentáveis de Processamento e de Monitorização de Qualidade de Produtos Alimentares do Mar” reference MAR-01.03.01-FEAMP-0050 cofunded by the Operational Programme Mar 2020, Portugal 2020 and the European Union through the European Fund for Maritime Affairs and Fisheries. The jury, composed by Dr. Liliana Anjos Guerreiro, auxiliary researcher at UALG/CCMAR (president), Professor Dr. Deborah Power group leader and full professor at UALG/CCMAR (member), and Dr. Patrícia Pinto auxiliary researcher at UALG/CCMAR (member) had the following points of the agenda: admission and evaluation of applications admitted to the call CCMAR/BINCGAM/10/2021.

#### II – Candidates

4 applications were received for the position:

Alexandra Carvalho Alves

Youssef Elamine

Paulo Jorge Rodrigues Machado

#### III - Exclusion of applications

The jury analysed the applications, considering the mandatory documents and the requirements, and decided to exclude 2 candidates (Table 1), for the following reasons:

Table 1. Candidates excluded of the evaluation and ranking phase.

Candidate ahmad marvi mashhadi, did not deliver a copy of the Master degree Certificate with the final classification (if awarded by a Portuguese Higher Education Institution) or a copy of the certificate of recognition of the Master degree by a Portuguese Public Higher Education Institution or by DGES – Directorate General for Higher Education (if the degree was awarded by a foreign University) with the conversion of the final classification in the Portuguese scale; as well as, did not deliver the **complete** declaration of honour, available from the application platform, is unable at the time of application, to provide a copy of the Master degree certificate with the final classification (if awarded by a Portuguese Higher Education Institution) or a copy of the certificate of recognition of the Master degree with the conversion of the final classification in the Portuguese scale (if the degree was awarded by a foreign University), as indicated above. This declaration was incomplete without the final classification and without the copy of the acknowledgement of the request for recognition of the Master degree (with the final classification) by a Portuguese Public Higher Education Institution or by DGES.

Candidate Paulo Jorge Rodrigues Machado does not have a master's degree and has not delivered a copy of the Master degree Certificate (if awarded by a Portuguese Higher Education Institution) or a copy of the certificate of recognition of the Master degree by a Portuguese Public Higher Education Institution or by DGES – Directorate General for Higher Education (if the degree was awarded by a foreign University).

Thus, 2 candidates were admitted to the evaluation and ranking phase (Table 2).

#### IV - Evaluation of applications

The Jury evaluated the application documents of the eligible candidates (Table 2) and applied the classification criteria and weighting factors set out in the vacancy announcement as shown in Table 3 below:

#### Evaluation criteria and respective weighting:

1. Master academic degree grade - 25%;
2. Proven experience in molecular biology activities that support protein analysis – 20%;
3. Proven experience in immunoassays - 20%;
4. Experience in molecular biology techniques in nucleic acids analysis and microbiology - 10%;
5. HACCP training for food safety and management systems – 5%;

- 6. Work experience in a scientific research laboratory - 15%;
- 7. Published scientific articles in the field of knowledge - 5%.

Note: The final grades in Table 3 represent the average of the individual evaluation performed by each member of the jury, presented on a scale from 0 to 20V.

Table 4 presents the overall classification in order of rank.

#### V - Conclusion

The candidates obtained a final classification between 10.35 and 12.25 values (Table 4), with the candidate Youssef Elamine having the highest classification (12.25 values; Table 4)

Considering the presented elements, the candidate Youssef Elamine meets the conditions for the purposes of eventual selection, so the Jury proposes the ratification of this decision to the CCMAR Board.

The Jury will proceed to the right of prior hearing of the candidates, setting a deadline of 10 working days to claim what they consider to be convenient, whether in relation to scientific or procedural matters.

With no other item on the agenda, the meeting of which these minutes were drawn up was closed, with 3 pages, and annex, which after being read and approved were signed by the members of the jury.
