I - Introduction

On the 3rd day of January two thousand twenty-three, at 12 hours and 15 minutes, the jury nominated by the CCMAR board of Directors on 12/12/2022, met in presential, for the meeting 2 of the call Ref. CCMAR/BM/35/2022 for the award of a Research Fellowship for a person with a bachelor's degree (Bolsa de Mestrado). The meeting was held for the award of a Research Fellowship (BM) for a person with a bachelor's degree (Bolsa de mestrado), through the project with reference *GERMROS- "Características da capacidade antioxidante das espermatogonias e o seu papel na tolerância ao stress oxidativo."* funded by FCT, the Portuguese Foundation for Science and Technology. The nominated jury was composed by Doctor Elvira Fatsini, researcher at CCMAR and coordinator of the project (President); Professor Elsa Cabrita, Professor at Algarve University and group leader (member) and Doctor Catarina Oliveira, researcher at UALG and CCMAR (Member), and had the following agenda items: admission and evaluation of applications admitted to the fellowship CCMAR/BM/35/2022.

III - Exclusion of applications

The jury analysed the applications, considering the mandatory documents, and decided to do not exclude the only candidate that applied.

Thus, one candidate was admitted to the evaluation and ranking phase (Table 2).

IV - Evaluation of applications

The Jury evaluated the application documents of the eligible candidates (Table 2) and applied the classification criteria and weighting factors set out in the vacancy announcement as shown in table 3 below:

Evaluation criteria and respective weighting:

1. Experience in molecular biology - 40 %;
2. Notion in Senegalese sole cell enrichment techniques – 35%;
3. English level - 25%;

Note: The final grades in table 3 represent the average of the individual evaluation performed by each member of the jury, presented on a scale from 0 to 20, rounded to the nearest tenth.

Table 4 presents the overall classification in order of rank.

V - Conclusion

The fellowships will be awarded to the best ranked applicant. The candidate Candela García Pichel having the highest classification (17 values; Table 4).



Thus, we declare under word of honor that we will not evaluate candidates with whom we have a conflict of interest, for what we will require our immediate replacement.


