

Minute 1

On the third day of November two thousand and twenty one, at 11 hours and 30 minutes, the jury nominated by the CCMAR board of Directors on 18/10/2021, met for the meeting 1 of the call Ref. CCMAR/BINCGAM/12/2021. The meeting was held for the award of a Research Fellowship for a person with a Master Degree (Bolsa de Investigação não conducente a grau académico para pessoa com mestrado) through the project with reference EXPL/BIA-ECO/1161/2021, named as “Olfactory Disruption in the Ria Formosa? Disrolf” funded by the Fundação para a Ciência e a Tecnologia, I.P./MCTES through national funding (PIDDAC). The nominated jury was composed by Dr. Peter Hubbard, Coordinator of the project and researcher at CCMAR (president of the jury), Professor Teresa Modesto, Professor at UALG and researcher at CCMAR (Member) and Dr. Zélia Velez, researcher at UALG and CCMAR (member) and had the following agenda items: the definition of the requirements, of the selection criteria and elaboration of the announcement of the present call.

Requirements:

Candidates must meet the following requirements:

1. M.Sc. in biological and/or analytical chemistry.
2. Experience in basic laboratory techniques.
3. Fluency in English and/or Portuguese.
4. Availability to start in January, 2022.
5. This fellowship may only be granted to those who do not exceed, with the conclusion of the present fellowship contract, an accumulated period of two years in this type of fellowship, consecutive or otherwise, to be confirmed through the candidate's CV.

Non-compliance justifies exclusion from the procedure.

Selection Criteria:

The selection committee reserves the right to contact and interview candidates if additional information or clarification of any curricular aspect is necessary.

The assessment will be in accordance with the following selection criteria:

- 1) CV and experience of the candidate (70%)
- 2) Final grade of M.Sc. (30%)

The selection committee reserves the right to contact and interview candidates if additional information or clarification of any curricular aspect is necessary. In case it takes place, the interview aims to evaluate in more detail the curricular items used to grade the candidate according to the list above.

In the eventuality that no applicant has the necessary profile, the selection committee reserves the right to close the call without any recruitment. In the event that the selected person does not take up the position because of failure to comply with documentary requirements or any other reason, or later during the contract if they resign, the jury reserves the right, upon convenience and opportunity, to assign the position

to the next applicant in accordance with the ranking positions based on the selectable list that can be used up to 6 months of the date of the present announcement.

Finally the jury prepared the announcement of the present call.

Without any other item, the present meeting has terminated. The present minute with 2 pages and annex was read, approved and shall be signed by the members of the jury.


