#### I - Introduction

On 28<sup>th</sup> day of the month of July, two thousand and twenty-three, at 9:00 hours, the jury nominated by the CCMAR board of Directors on 04/07/2023, met by video conference, for the meeting 2 of the call Ref. CCMAR/TI/12/2023.
